Guide to Environmental Biosecurity Kits for Butchulla Aboriginal Corporation Vehicles

Help to reduce the risk of introducing & dispersing of weeds, pests & pathogens:

- Clean vehicles & equipment before travelling to K'gari
- Be aware of weeds, pests & pathogens & watch out for them try to avoid carrying them on your boots, clothing & vehicles
- Use the Biosecurity Kit in your vehicle
- Clean equipment after working in a site & before travelling to the next site
- for more information Check the BAC K'gari Environmental Biosecurity Threat Map & Plan & the BAC Environmental Biosecurity Surveillance Guideline & Reporting Plan

Each kit should contain:

- <u>1 spray bottle (1L)</u> containing 20ml Phytoclean (100ml) & water
- 2. <u>1 nail brush</u> use to remove dirt from underneath nails
- 3. <u>1 packet of antibacterial wipes</u> use to clean dirty hands & equipment
- 4. <u>1 bottle of hand sanitiser</u> use to clean dirty hands after using antibacterial wipes to remove dirt
- 5. <u>1 roll of paper towel</u> use with diluted Phytoclean (see 1) to clean equipment & boots
- 6. <u>Thick plastic bags (black)</u> use to contain weeds & weed seed & use a separate bag to contain used disposable gloves, paper towel & antibacterial wipes, ensure that bags are tied/sealed securely before disposal
- 7. <u>1 dustpan brush</u> use to brush off dirty clothes, boots & equipment, brush weed seed into bags (see 6)
- 8. <u>2 scrubbing brushes</u> use to scrub boots & appropriate equipment
- 9. <u>1 box of disposable gloves</u> dispose of gloves (see 6) after each use
- 10. <u>1 pair of large gardening gloves</u> use antibacterial wipes (see 3) to clean gloves after each use
- 11. <u>1 pair of medium gardening gloves</u> use antibacterial wipes (see 3) to clean gloves after each use

12. <u>BAC K'gari Environmental Biosecurity Threat Map & Plan</u> & <u>BAC Environmental Biosecurity Surveillance Guideline & Reporting Plan</u> – printed copies should be replaced & staff notified with every update made

All brushes (see 2, 7 & 8) should be washed with water & sprayed with diluted Phytoclean (see 1) after each use
