

Guide to Environmental Biosecurity Kits for Butchulla Aboriginal Corporation Vehicles

Help to reduce the risk of introducing & dispersing of weeds, pests & pathogens:

- Clean vehicles & equipment before travelling to K'gari
- Be aware of weeds, pests & pathogens & watch out for them – try to avoid carrying them on your boots, clothing & vehicles
- Use the Biosecurity Kit in your vehicle
- Clean equipment after working in a site & before travelling to the next site

Each kit should contain:

1. 1 spray bottle (1L) – containing 20ml Phytoclean (100ml) & water
2. 1 nail brush – use to remove dirt from underneath nails
3. 1 packet of antibacterial wipes – use to clean dirty hands & equipment
4. 1 bottle of hand sanitiser – use to clean dirty hands after using antibacterial wipes to remove dirt
5. 1 roll of paper towel – use with diluted Phytoclean (see 1) to clean equipment & boots
6. Thick plastic bags (black) – use to contain weeds & weed seed & use a separate bag to contain used disposable gloves, paper towel & antibacterial wipes, ensure that bags are tied/sealed securely before disposal
7. 1 dustpan brush – use to brush off dirty clothes, boots & equipment, brush weed seed into bags (see 6)
8. 2 scrubbing brushes – use to scrub boots & appropriate equipment
9. 1 box of disposable gloves – dispose of gloves (see 6) after each use
10. 1 pair of large gardening gloves – use antibacterial wipes (see 3) to clean gloves after each use
11. 1 pair of medium gardening gloves – use antibacterial wipes (see 3) to clean gloves after each use
12. BAC K'gari Environmental Biosecurity Threat Map & Plan & BAC Environmental Biosecurity Surveillance Guideline & Reporting Plan – printed copies should be replaced & staff notified with every update made

All brushes (see 2, 7 & 8) should be washed with water & sprayed with diluted Phytoclean (see 1) after each use
